



## **Infection Prevention Guidelines for Visitors in Cultural Affairs Bureau Performance Venues**

For the prevention of “COVID-19”, the Cultural Affairs Bureau has referenced relevant guidelines published by the Health Bureau (SS) and formulated the following public infection prevention guidelines:

### **Before Entering**

- Audience can enter the venue 45 minutes prior to the performance;
- Audience should line up at designated area, with an arm's length apart, before entering to facilitate the implementation of the prevention measures.
- All personnel must wear face masks, receive temperature check and present their “Health Code” for inspection. Only those with temperature below 37°C and the “Health Code” indicated as green (entry permitted), can enter the venue.
- Those with forehead temperature over 37°C or with respiratory symptoms are not allowed to enter and should immediately seek medical consultation.

### **After Entering**

- Please use alcoholic hand sanitizers to disinfect both hands;
- Please wear masks at all times and only take it off when necessary.
- Avoid gathering. Please maintain a social distance of at least 1 meter with other people;
- After the activity ends, please do not stay behind and leave the venue in an orderly manner with distance apart.
- Please maintain personal hygiene. Eating and drinking is not allowed in the venue;
- Crowd control measure is implemented in each venue to control the number of people entering. If the number of people has reached the limit, please comply with instructions given by venue staff to enter or leave the venue.
