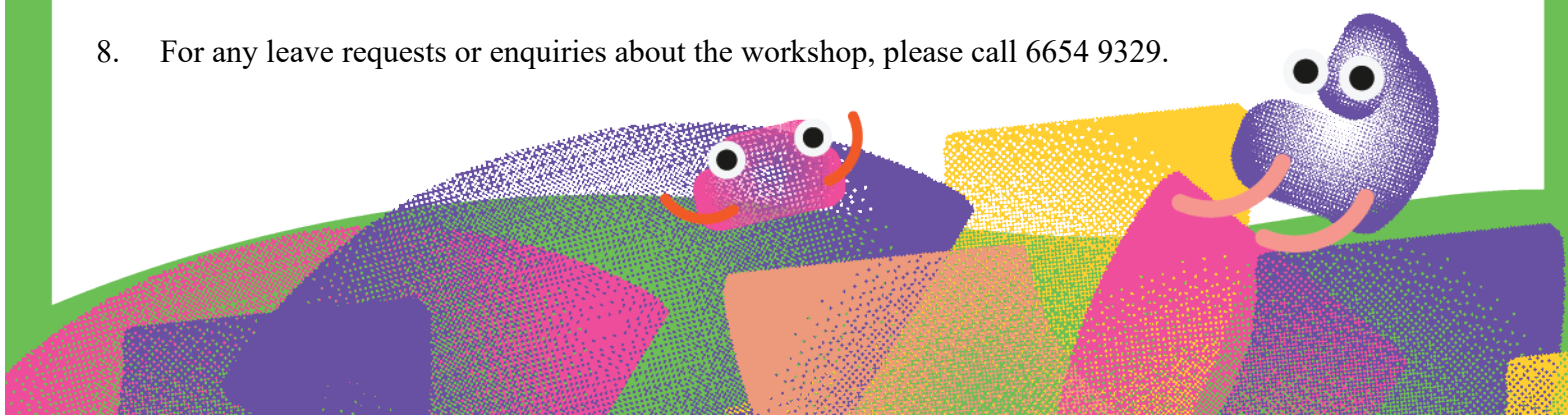


**Workshops of the Macao International Children's Arts Festival**  
**Instructions for Participants and Adverse Weather Arrangements**

1. Participants should arrive at the Macao Cultural Centre 15 minutes in advance and proceed to the registration counter as directed. Upon registration, please present the registration receipt and identity document (or a copy thereof) for verification;
2. Participants are advised to wear light casual clothing, bring their own drinking water bottles, and avoid bringing valuables;
3. Participants must switch off their mobile phones and other beeping devices during the workshop;
4. Photography, audio and video recording are prohibited during the workshop unless expressly authorised by the Cultural Affairs Bureau (IC);
5. Activities will be photographed or videotaped by IC staff for archival or evaluation purposes. Some of the photographs may be used for promotion of similar activities without consent from the participants in advance;
6. Participants must follow the guidance of the workshop instructor. IC reserves the right to ask the participants to leave the venue in case the activities are seriously disrupted by their behaviour;
7. IC reserves the right to change the activity and the instructor;

9. Provisions in case of rainstorm and typhoon: workshops with admission fees

<p><b>Target Workshops</b></p>	<p>Applicable to workshops designated for children aged below 3 years old, including ‘The Common Language Between My Baby and Me’, ‘Little Eyes “Listen” to the Big World’, ‘I Am a Music Fan’, ‘Storytelling &amp; Creation’ (Class A to E), ‘Let’s Go! Dynamic Amusement Park’ (Class A and B), ‘The Great Musical Adventure’ (Class A and B), ‘Storytelling &amp; Creation’ (Family Class A to D)</p>	<p>Applicable to workshops designated for children aged 4 years old and above.</p>
<p><b>Rainstorm Warning Signal</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ If a yellow rainstorm warning signal is in force, the workshop will be held as scheduled, and participants may decide whether to attend;</li> <li>■ If a red rainstorm warning signal is still in force two hours prior to the start of the workshop, the IC will decide whether to cancel or postpone the workshop, depending on the situation and will inform participants by phone;</li> <li>■ If the black rainstorm warning signal is hoisted two hours prior to the workshop, the event will be suspended/cancelled or postponed.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ If a yellow or red rainstorm warning signal is in force, the workshop will be held as scheduled and participants may decide whether to attend;</li> <li>■ If the black rainstorm warning signal is hoisted two hours prior to the workshop, the event will be suspended/cancelled or postponed.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Typhoon Signal</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ If typhoon signal no. 1 is hoisted, the workshop will be held as scheduled and participants may decide whether to attend;</li> <li>■ If typhoon signal no. 3 or above is hoisted two hours prior to the start of the workshop, or if typhoon signal no. 3 or above is hoisted within two hours prior to the start of the activity, the IC will decide whether to suspend/cancel or postpone the workshop depending on the situation and will inform participants by phone.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ If typhoon signal no. 1 or 3 is in force, the workshop will be held as scheduled and participants may decide whether to attend;</li> <li>■ If typhoon signal no. 8 or above is hoisted at/after 8am, all workshops for that day will be suspended/cancelled or postponed.</li> <li>■ All workshops will be suspended/cancelled or postponed two hours prior to the hoisting of typhoon signal no. 8 or above.</li> </ul>
