

Introduction



The Macao International Parade is an annual artistic event organised by the Cultural Affairs Bureau, in collaboration with various government departments and entities, and supported by civic entities. The then "Parade through Macao, Latin City" was held for the first time in 2011 and has become one of the city's annual events celebrating Macao's handover to China, as well as an important cultural brand of the city. In 2017, the "Parade through Macao, Latin City" was renamed "Macao International Parade". From its 10th edition in 2024, the event is jointly organised by the Cultural Affairs Bureau, SJM Resorts, S.A., Sands China Ltd., MGM, Galaxy Entertainment Group, Wynn Resorts (Macau), S. A. and Melco Resorts & Entertainment, further expanding its scale, intensifying international cultural and artistic exchange, and showcasing Macao's unique charm to the world.

The "2025 Macao International Parade" will gather performing groups from all over the world and extraordinary local artists, who will sing and dance in their distinctive costumes and styles along bustling streets filled with a rich cultural atmosphere, highlighting the city's unique landscapes, promoting the spirit of "Love, Peace and Cultural Integration", facilitating the interactive cultural and artistic exchange. As Macao was designated a "Culture City of East Asia 2025", this year's Parade also promotes the spirit of "Symbiosis, Innovation and Harmony" of the latter, echoing with the theme "East-West Encounter, Asia in Harmony" of the "Culture City of East Asia" and showcasing the charm of Macao's cultural integration and innovation.

This year's Parade will feature artistic groups from various regions, including Portugal, France, Spain, Italy, Germany, Morocco, India, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Polynesia, Argentina, Egypt, Mainland China and Hong Kong. Additionally, representative artistic groups from the three other cities designated as "Culture Cities of East Asia 2025", including Huzhou (China), Anseong (South Korea) and Kamakura (Japan), were invited to participate in the event to present the characteristics of their cities. A total of 23 artistic groups from 15 countries and regions will join the 60 local participating groups, totalling an estimated number of nearly 1,800 artists.

This year's Parade features the same route as in 2024, starting from the Ruins of St. Paul's, passing through the distinctive Senado Square and Cathedral Square, proceeding along the lively Avenida Panorâmica do Lago Nam Van, and finally converging in Sai Van Lake Square. Various performing arts groups will stage a vibrant and artistic celebration, showcasing the charm of Macao as a "Culture City of East Asia" and inviting the spectators to witness the launching of the programme of the "Culture City of East Asia 2025".

Due to the organisation of the Parade, the following crowd and traffic control measures will be implemented:

- · All tourism buses must leave the parking area at Rua de D. Belchior Carneiro before 2pm on 22 March:
- Parking meters and parking spaces along the Parade route will be closed from 9am on 22 March to 7pm on 23 March;
- From 12pm to 5pm on 23 March, limited access restrictions will be taken at the intersections and stretches of Rua de S. Paulo, Rua da Palha, Largo de S. Domingos and Travessa do Roquete. In addition, the following streets will be temporarily closed to traffic during the designated periods, in whichparking vehicles will not be allowed to move during the following periodsof time:

The Parade brings joy and merriment to the celebration of Macao's handover, while offering an opportunity to promote the city's cultural characteristics abroad and showcase the unique charm of Macao.

In order to further showcase Macao's unique characteristics as a city where Chinese and Western cultures meet, the opening ceremony of the "Culture City of East Asia 2025 – Macao, China" is held concurrently with the "Macao International Parade". Artistic groups from the three other cities designated as "Culture Cities of East Asia 2025", including Huzhou (China), Kamakura (Japan) and Anseong (South Korea), were also invited to participate in the event, showcasing the charm of Macao's cultural integration and its profound cultural essence through in-depth cultural exchanges on stage, solidifying Macao's role as "a base for exchange and cooperation where Chinese culture is the mainstream and diverse cultures coexist", strengthening internal and external connectivity, showcasing the charm of Chinese culture to the world, and creating a vital window for exchange and mutual understanding between Chinese and Western civilizations.

This year, the Parade features several highlights. World-renowned artistic groups, experienced in performing internationally where they have demonstrated high-level artistic competence, perform in Macao, adding an international touch to the event. All foreign performing groups participate in the Parade for the first time, bringing new styles of performance and injecting new energy and multicultural elements into the event. The participating art groups cover the five continents, presenting a rich and colourful range of cultural customs, allowing the audience to feel the artistic charm of different regions of the world. On the other hand, local groups showcase the artistic power of the "Culture City of East Asia" with its unique creativity and cultural heritage, as well as perform in cooperation with groups from the Greater Bay Area and abroad.

VIVA, the mascot of the Parade, will also lead the audience on a fantastic adventure across time and space, conveying the beauty of Macao's cultural integration and opening a unique chapter where East and West meet. Through a blend of light and shadow, music and dance, the audience is immersed in a vibrant dream world, enjoys the artistic feast with the performers and feels the infinite charm of art.




