Call for Proposals by Local Parade Groups - “2019 Macao International Parade”

Preface

In the celebration of the 20th Anniversary of Macao’s Handover to China, the Cultural Affairs Bureau will host the “2019 Macao International Parade” on 8 December.

The parade features the history and culture of countries and regions in Central Asia, Northern Asia, Western Asia, the Indian Ocean and the Mediterranean Sea, known as the “Silk Road Economic Belt and the 21st century Maritime Silk Road” or “Belt and Road Initiative”. The theme encourages artists to create ideas, broaden their international cultural horizons, and promote "Love, Peace and Cultural Integration."

The Cultural Affairs Bureau is now calling for participants to join this big event, welcoming all the registered local arts groups, schools, institutes and organizations to submit proposals.

Categories for Applications

Below options are available for applicants:

- A) Local groups can participate the parade day in either way:
1. “Themed Parade Group”: Participating groups can refer to the list of "Belt and Road Initiative" countries in Appendix to develop their own theme based on the culture or folklore from the countries or regions. Presentations in any art forms, such as drama, physical theatre, dance, or music, etc. are all welcome. Applicants of “Themed Parade Groups” should as well develop a performance showcase according to the chosen theme. The performance should not exceed 2 minutes and is taken place at Avenida Panorâmica do Lago Nam Van. Judges will evaluate each performance and select the award winners. Should there be more than 2 groups select the same country theme, a lucky draw will be made.
 2. “Artistic Parade Group”: With no designated themes, participating groups could freely work with their own artistic characteristics, and compete for some of the awards.
- B) Or can participate below outreach programs:
3. “Art Promotion Mini Parade”: Participating groups could join the mini parade on 30 November or 1 December to promote arts and the Parade in the community; the mini parade will be held at Ruins of St. Paul’s, Jardim de Luís de Camões and Jardim de Iao Hon.
 4. “Community Art Program”: Participating groups should present a performance, workshop, exhibition, sharing or interactive program between 30 minutes to 2 hours during 18 November to 7 December in different local communities or schools with the purpose of promoting arts and the Parade. Groups are welcome to invite foreign artists to work together. Venue can be suggested by participating groups or coordinated by IC. Programs are selected based on their creativity and community Interactivity.

6 & 7 December 2019 (Fri & Sat)

Attendance from group representatives is compulsory, large props to be used on the Parade day must be brought along in rehearsal as well.

3. Date of Mini Parade

30 November & 1 December (Sat & Sun), exact location to be announced.

4. Group Size

Participating groups should arrange appropriate number of performers and staff according to the operational needs. Adjustments might be made by the Bureau if necessary.

5. Application

Interested parties have to prepare a proposal (in both disc/USB and printed copy format) and submit from 2 to 8 September (10am to 6pm, open during lunch hour) to Division of Recreational Activities, Cultural Affairs Bureau (Address: Avenida da Praia Grande, no. 517, 11th floor A, "Nam Tung" Commercial Building).
