INTRODUCTION

The "Macao International Parade" is an annual artistic event, organized by the Cultural Affairs Bureau and co-organized by various government departments and entities and supported by civic entities. The "Parade through Macau, Latin City" was held for the first time in 2011 and has become one of the city's annual events celebrating Macao's handover to China, as well as an important cultural brand of the city. In 2017, the "Parade through Macau, Latin City" was renamed "Macao International Parade", hoping that the event will move towards internationalization, demonstrating the unique charm of Macao.

Themed around the cultures of countries and regions along the initiative "One Belt, One Road", this year's Parade invited local and international performing groups to present the unique cultures of these regions and Macao as well as its ambience of cultural integration, promoting cultural and artistic exchange. The Parade brings joy and merriment to the celebration of Macao's handover, while promoting the city's unique cultural features abroad and deepening the public's understand-ing of the countries and regions along the initiative "One Belt, One Road".

This year's Parade features the same route as last year, starting from the Ruins of St. Paul's, passing through the distinctive Senado Square and Cathedral Square, proceeding along the lively Avenida Panorâmica do Lago Nam Van and finally converging in Sai Van Lake Square to celebrate the handover, a feast of "Love, Peace and Cultural Integration".

The Parade kicks off on 8 December (Sunday), at 3pm, at the Ruins of St. Paul's, passing through Rua de S. Paulo, Largo de S. Domingos, Senado Square, Travessa do Roquete, Cathedral Square, Avenida da Praia Grande, Avenida Panorâmica do Lago Nam Van and Avenida Doutor Stanley Ho, and finally arriving at Sai Van Lake Square at 6:30pm, to celebrate the handover.

Themed around the cultures of countries and regions along the initiative "One Belt, One Road", elite artists will sing and dance along the streets of rich cultural interesting bustling with animation.

PARADE HIGHLIGHTS

Handover Celebration

The Parade brings joy and merriment to the celebration of Macao's handover, while offering an opportunity to promote the city's culture abroad, demonstrating the unique charm of Macao.

Cultural Window

The annual Parade promotes Macao as an excellent cultural exchange platform between China and the West, allowing Macao to further its role of "cultural window". The "Parade through Macao, Latin City" was renamed "Macao International Parade" in 2017, taking a step forward in advancing the internationalization of multicultural exchanges and creating more cultural cooperation opportunities between Macao and the world. This year, the Parade is themed around the cultures of countries and regions along the initiative "One Belt, One Road", showing the city's atmosphere of cultural integration and facilitating the cultural and artistic exchange.

Arts Exchange

This year, local groups can join the Parade in various categories, including "Themed Parade Group" which allows all groups to compete with other groups and be eligible for awards; "Artistic Parade Group" which allows participants to present free-themed performances according to their own characteristics. Registered groups may also participate in the "Art Promotion Mini Parade" category, promoting arts and the Parade close by the community, or in the "Assigned Art Ambassadors" category, in which participating groups will work with schools to teach how to produce props and plan a parade, aiming at promoting artistic exchanges in the community.

Residents' Participation

The members of the public not only can go through the streets and alleys on the day of the Parade, having fun together with the performing groups and experiencing the atmosphere of cultural integration of the city, but also play the interactive game on WeChat for a chance to win fabulous prizes. In addition, they can participate in the "Most Popular Group" voting activity and vote for their favourite parade group!
